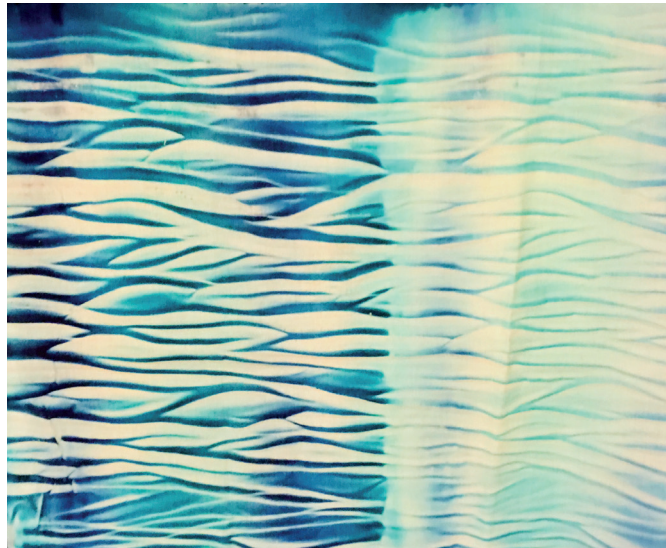


# SHIBORI STYLE DYEING USING MARABU FASHION SPRAYS.

Use thin, prewashed, lightweight fabric, natural or 20 % synthetic mix.

1. Moisten fabric so the dye will spread.
2. Fold the fabric and firmly hold in place using rubber bands or string.

For the example below, wrap the fabric around a piece of plastic tubing. Fix in several places with string. Push the fabric up the tubing and spray with colours.



3. Use a generous amount of dye which will enable it to penetrate into the folds. Those areas that are tied will remain white.
4. After spraying, let dry for at least 30 minutes or preferably overnight.
5. Remove rubber bands or string with a pair of scissors and carefully unfold the fabric.
6. Iron to fix.



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
