## Decorating fabric with Pre cut Stencils and Oil Paintstiks

**Step I.** Create registration lines on fabric with a ruler and pencil or fold fabric in half from side to side and iron to create a vertical registration line and top to bottom to create a horizontal line.

Step 2. Prepare stencils. Spray the back of the stencil with Nuart Spray adhesive

**Step 3.** Position Stencil A so that two of the alignment guides are even with the registration lines on the fabric. Take a Shiva Oilpaintstik and colour onto Richeson disposable palette paper. Using a stencil brush, pick up the colour from the paper and paint onto fabric. Lift the stencil from the fabric and gently wipe off any excess paint from the front and back of the stencil.

**Step 4.** Place stencil B next to the first painted image, rotating the stencil until the images on the stencil match up properly with the images you just painted. Paint image, remove stencil and wipe any excess paint off.

**Step 5.** Continue alternating between stencil A and B until you have completed.

**Step 6.** Let dry and iron to make colourfast. Clean stencils and brushes with Zest-It Oil Paint Dilutant.
