MARABU POURIGEUD

Materials:

- Marabu pouring fluid MC123213
- Canvas board CANB+
- Marabu Acrylic paint
- Atelier free flow ATF250+
- OR Other acrylic paints





- Prepare your work area with plastic and elevate your canvas board (or surface to paint) so its not touching the work area so extra paint can flow off.
- Pour each acrylic paint colour into a separate cup and add several parts of Pouring Fluid. Stir with a spatula or stick. If necessary, add more fluid until the desired consistency of runny cream is achieved.
- You can pour one colour as a base over the canvas to prime it so the paint flows better
- Technique 1. Pour each colour onto the canvas and tilt the canvas in different directions so the paints flow together OR
- Technique 2. Create a dirty pour by pouring each colour into a mixing cup one after the other.
- Place the canvas on top of the cup and quickly flip both over. Wait until the paint has run out of the cup
- Carefully lift the cup from the canvas and tilt until the desired result has been achieved.
- The artwork will take several days to dry. Make sure your canvas is positioned horizontally so the paint does not continue to run off.
