How to use

Atelier Pouring Medium

- 1. Choose your acrylic paint colours. They need to be a runny consistency if it's too thick, add tap water to thin the paint. Place each colour in a disposable cup.
- **2.** Add Atelier Pouring Medium.

 (As a general rule, 1/4 cup of pouring medium is required to 1 cup of paint).
- 3. Add 3-4 drops of silicone oil and mix slowly.
- **4.** For a dirty pour, combine your colours into 1 cup but do not mix.



5. Sit your canvas ontop of the cup and turn over. Gradually remove your cup and tilt your board so the paint covers the area.



- **6.** For a clean pour, pour colours directly onto your board (on top of each other) and tilt the board to cover it. *Works best with Atelier Free Flow or Chromocryl Fluid Concentrate.
- **7.** Use a butane torch to release the cells on your artwork.



- **8.** Leave your artwork in a clean, level and elevated space to dry.
- **9.** This may take 1-2 days to cure depending on environmental factors.
