MONOPRINTING ONTO PAPER

Monoprinting is a simple technique to create an effective background.

Simply place dobs of acrylic paint in the centre area of a sheet of acetate .

Place a second sheet of acetate over the top and blend the colours with your finger. Separate the two sheets and place the acetate, design side down onto the paper. Press evenly on the back with your hand, for good contact between image and paper.

Alternatively for varying effects you can draw into the colour before placing the paper over the top.
